WHEN: February 28, 2009, Saturday 8:00AM - 2:00PM

WHERE: Chinese Baptist Church (5801 Beacon Ave S, Seattle, WA 98108)

**WHY:** To increase the Asian & Pacific Islander blood donor pool and make sure that all patients receive the blood that they need. Every weekday, the Puget Sound Blood Center (PSBC) needs 900 donors to meet the transfusion needs in Western Washington. This drive is a tribute to Kirby Wong, who needed over 500 units of blood products in his fight for life.

#### HOW:

The entire process takes less than an hour.

- Blood Bank has a screening interview with each donor.
- Your blood pressure, pulse, temperature, and red cell count are taken.
- Your unit of blood is collected.
- You should rest for 10 minutes, while refreshments are served.

#### Can I Donate?

## YES, If You:

- Are in good health
- At least 18 years old (age 16 or 17 with parent's permission slip)
- Weigh at least 110 pounds

Donation is allowed for the following conditions:

- Diabetes under control with medication
- Menstruating
- Allergy medications, diuretics, diet pills, sleeping pills, tranquilizers, aspirin, Tylenol
- Blood pressure medication (most types)
- Flu vaccination
- Hepatitis B vaccination
- Ear / body piercing by a professional

### NO, You Must WAIT, If You:

- Have cold, flu and sore throat until symptom free for three days
- Are taking oral antibiotics until three days after last dose and symptom free
- Have malaria three year wait or until symptom free
- Have been in a malaria area one year wait
- Had a delivery, miscarriage, or abortion six week wait
- Had a surgery with a transfusion one year wait
- Had Measles (rubella) and MMR vaccinations One month wait
- Had ear / body piercing by non-professionals if sterile procedure, can donate
- Had tattooing One year wait
- Traveled anywhere outside of the city in Belize in August 2007 one year wait

### NO, You Cannot Donate If You:

- Have HIV / Aids
- Have a cold or flu
- Had hepatitis after the age of 11
- Are pregnant
